

Broadcast Journalism Internship

Lowell TeleMedia Center (LTC) is a membership-based non-profit media center serving Lowell MA. LTC operates three channels on the cable TV system, and offers training, equipment, and facilities for the production and distribution of community-oriented TV programs and podcasts. LTC staff and interns produce a bi-weekly half-hour news program, "LTC News."

Interns receive on-the-job training in producing documentary-style news segments and studio interviews for the weekly program, LTC News. Interns will have the opportunity to produce their own stories and serve as show anchor. LTC media production classes are available to interns free of charge.

Responsibilities:

- Produce documentary-style news segments about events, issues, and interesting people in Lowell
- Pre-production and production: research, script, shoot, and edit video. Interns have free access to LTC's two HD TV studios, professional video cameras and DSLR cameras, audio equipment, and editing suites with Final Cut Pro X and Adobe Premiere
- Serve as a show anchor in the LTC studio with a teleprompter
- Assist staff with news production activities

Qualifications:

- Familiarity with digital video production and digital editing
- Ability to get to and from a variety of locations in and around Lowell
- Able to lift 20-40 pounds of production equipment
- Experience with news and script-writing

This internship is unpaid. Flexible schedule during LTC's open hours: Monday through Thursday from 10:00am to 9:00pm, Fridays from 10:00am to 6:00pm, and Saturdays from 10:00am to 2:00pm. Ten hour/week minimum. College credit available. Supervised by LTC staff.
